In line with the Education Bureau's new senior secondary academic structure effective since 2009, the school will continue to implement a coherent and diversified senior secondary curriculum. In addition to the 4 core subjects of Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics and Liberal Studies, each student will choose either 2 or 3 elective subjects based on the curriculum design and their own academic requirements for further education. To help us understand S3 students' preferences for S4 subjects, parents are kindly requested to discuss this matter with your child and indicate their preferences in the survey form below. Please browse the Education Bureau's website (http://www.edb.gov.hk/334) beforehand to learn about the New Senior Secondary Academic Structure and the latest enrollment requirements of local universities.

To help students and parents understand the new senior secondary curriculum and the subjects on offer, the school has organized three New Senior Secondary curriculum talks on 7 Dec, 2016, 24 March, 2017 and 3 April, 2017 respectively, and a S3 parents' Day was held on 5 March (Sunday) to provide the latest information about the New Senior Secondary curriculum.

^{*} S4 students choosing 2 or 3 elective subjects were grouped in different classes in 2016-17. A similar arrangement will be in place in the 2017-18 school year. The final combination of subjects in 2017-18 will be based on factors such as the school's resources, students' overall preferences, and the sustainability of subject combinations.

Students can choose 2 (2X) or 3 (3X) elective subjects based on their competences, preferences or interests. Students with better performance in mathematics can also take Mathematics Module 1 or Module 2. To broaden their scope of learning, students may adopt a 'science plus art' or 'art, science and business' approach. Some examples of combination of subjects are listed below:

Example 1 (3X): Biology + Physics + Visual Arts

Example 2 (2X): Chinese History + Information and Communication Technology

Example 3 (2X): Chemistry + Geography

Example 4 (3X): Business, Accounting and Financial Studies + Physics + Chinese Literature

Example 5 (3X): Chemistry + Biology + Physics + M2

Students who prefer pure art combinations may consider:

Example 6 (3X): Chinese History + Chinese Literature + History

Students who prefer business combinations may consider:

Example 7 (2X): Business, Accounting and Financial Studies + Economics + Mathematics M1
