The aims of Secondary 1-3 History curriculum are:

- (a) to enhance and develop students' interest in studying history;

整體教學重點

- (a) 透過學習國家在世界歷史不同階段的發展,以及與香港發展相關的課題,使學生從歷史與文化角度了解國家安全的重要性,進而認同維護政治 安全及文化安全的必要性。
- (b) 初中歷史科包括了「早期香港地區的歷史、文化與傳承」、「香港直至 19 世紀末的成長與發展」、「20 世紀香港的成長與蛻變」等課題,讓學生從歷史的視角理解「香港自古以來就是中國的領土」的歷史事實,以及香港的發展與國家歷史和文化的緊密關連。
- (c) 透過研習歷史科,能讓學生認識到國家從被列強侵略,以致英國佔領香港,及後國家克服困難,並恢復對本港行使主權的奮進歷程,培養學生的國民意識及國家觀念,從而強化學生對國家民族的使命感和責任心,以及配合課程中其他關於世界不同文化和地域的歷史,最終幫助他們成為負責任的公民及具備世界視野的中國人。

香港國家安全教育課程框架

學習元素

- 1. 透過教授鴉片戰爭(1840-1842),以及戰後英國割佔香港並實施殖民管治的歷史(例如透過對香港早期年報、憲報進行專題研習,讓學生了解港督擁有極大權力,政府高層官員亦全由英人出任、華人受到不平等對待等),讓學生明白維護國家主權、領土完整對國家安全的重要性。
- 2. 認識本地華人團體(例如東華三院、保良局)對香港的貢獻。透過學習本地不同華人團體的成立背景及其在香港發展所擔演的角色,包括這些團體所提供的慈惠服務及貢獻(例如到東華三院文物館作實地考察,在課堂觀看講述東華三院歷史的電影「東風破」,了解東華三院贈醫施藥、並協助去世的海外華人原籍安葬等),培養學生欣賞中國傳統文化中救濟、慈惠的美德,加強民族和文化認同感,並明白香港雖在英國殖民管治下仍然與內地關係密切。
